# Infant Toddler Music: "Clap, Clap, Clap Your Hands" Song

## **Learning Value:**

Simple songs with repeating words encourage language development. This song also provides an interactive way to encourage movement and expression.

### **Materials Needed:**

#### **Participants:**

This activity is intended for adult/child interaction.

### **Directions:**

**Step 1:** As you sing to your child, exaggerate the movements with your hands and body.

Step 2: Sing the lyrics to the tune of "Row, Row, Row Your Boat"

Clap, clap, clap your hands. Clap them one, two, three. Clap, clap, clap your hands. Clap them just like me! Roll, roll, roll your hands. Roll them one, two, three. Roll, roll, roll your hands. Roll them just like me!

Step 3: Rotate between showing your child the movements of the song and supporting him or her in moving to the song on their own.
